a variety of media used in a work of art

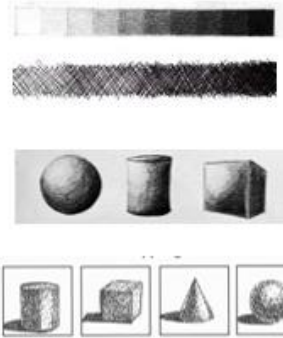

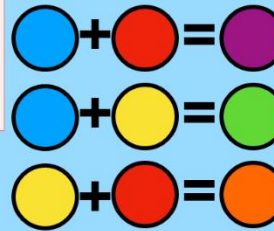
Changing the pressure of your pencil to create tone. Using directional shading to emphasise form.

Tone



Painting Tips.

1. Wash the brush in between colours by swirling it around in the water
2. Gently stir to mix water and paint together in the pallet
3. Use the tip of the brush for a thin neat line (and to do outlines first)
4. Use the side of the brush for a thick line (and fill big spaces neatly)
5. Twist the brush to remove water and maintain the pointed shape you need to be accurate.

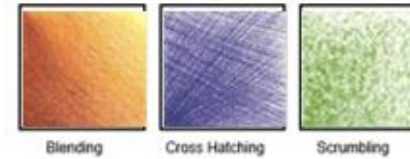

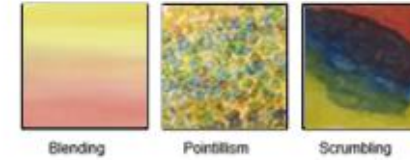
